- There is a \$100 adoption fee in CASH for a cat, includes Spay/Neuter Certificate for a kitten that has not been fixed. If adopting an unfixed kitten, you as the adopter will sign a legally binding adoption agreement that YOU will get kitten spayed/neutered.
- If the adoption does not work out and you can no longer keep the cat at any time, we will take the cat back. However, you may have to hold on to the cat for a week or two until we have an opening in a foster home. We will make every attempt to get the cat back as soon as possible.
- We have volunteers who do follow up phone calls and/or visits to the home.
- We follow up to make sure the cat gets vaccinated (specifically for distemper) on a yearly basis.
